

PCP Champion Toolkit

Responsibility of the Role:

- Share the rational and clinic motivation for delivering Collaborative Care, describe benefits to patients and staff
- Lead efforts to communicate practice change and new workflow expectations to PCP colleagues
- Support PCP group in identifying and overcoming challenges or formulating constructive alternatives in implementing Collaborative Care

Suggested Schedule of Activities:

Ahead of Launch:

- Orientation to Collaborative Care
- Offering opportunities for training
- Identify and overcome challenges or concerns

Launch:

- Share workflows
- Identify and overcome challenges or concerns

Post-Launch:

- Share successes
- Identify and overcome challenges or concerns

Training Outline for PCP Team Engagement (See Planning Sheet)

- Pick a time (Provider meeting, Rolling information session)
- Determine content (See possible education materials below)
- Reward attention (Share meaningful resources like Commonly Prescribed Psychotropic Medications sheet)
- Decide on appropriate team to present material (Project lead, BHCM, PC?)
- Ongoing promotion and support (Sharing successes)
