BEHAVIORAL HEALTH CARE MANAGER ROLE

The Behavioral Health Care Manager (BHCM) is a critically important member of the Collaborative Care team. The BHCM coordinates the overall effort of the team, ensures effective communication among team members, and coordinates all care management tasks, including offering psychotherapy when that is part of the treatment plan. The BHCM is a behavioral health professional, typically a counselor, clinical social worker, psychologist, or psychiatric nurse. Sometimes this role is shared by a licensed provider and a non-licensed provider like a medical assistant, community health worker, or a person with bachelor's level training.

CORE GOALS

- Understand the Collaborative Care Model (CoCM) and its approach to integrated physical and mental health care
- Understand the BHCM role on a CoCM team and how the BHCM interacts with other providers on the team (including primary care providers and Psychiatric Consultants)
- Review the BHCM responsibilities for CoCM around: identifying and engaging patients; assessing and diagnosing; providing measurement-based treatment to target; managing a caseload of patients

ONBOARDING STRUCTURE

The BHCM training consists of several components, as shown below. Please use this information to be sure you are completing the components as required. A breakdown of the estimated time to complete each component is provided. Many components are self-paced and can be completed over the course of multiple sessions.
